Finished size will measure 12.5 x 12.5 inches, including the seam allowance.

Always cut your background slightly bigger, as in the process of stitching your pieces the background will shrink a bit.


You can trim the block down to size afterwards.














Step 3
Trace and cut out pieces D, E. The body and top of head.
Don't heat press these yet, just place them down for now.




Step 4
Trace and cut the beak and toes.
The beak is F.
The toes is M,L,K,J,I,H.
The bottom pieces can now be heat pressed. But not the head yet.




Step 5
Trace and cut Piece G.
This is the face of the owl. Making sure that the head piece is in the correct position, you can now heat press the top half of the owl.



Step 6
Trace and cut pieces N, O. The Eyes.
Place down and heat press.



Step 7
The final step.
Trace and cut pieces P,Q, the pupils in the eyes.
Place them down and heat press.
