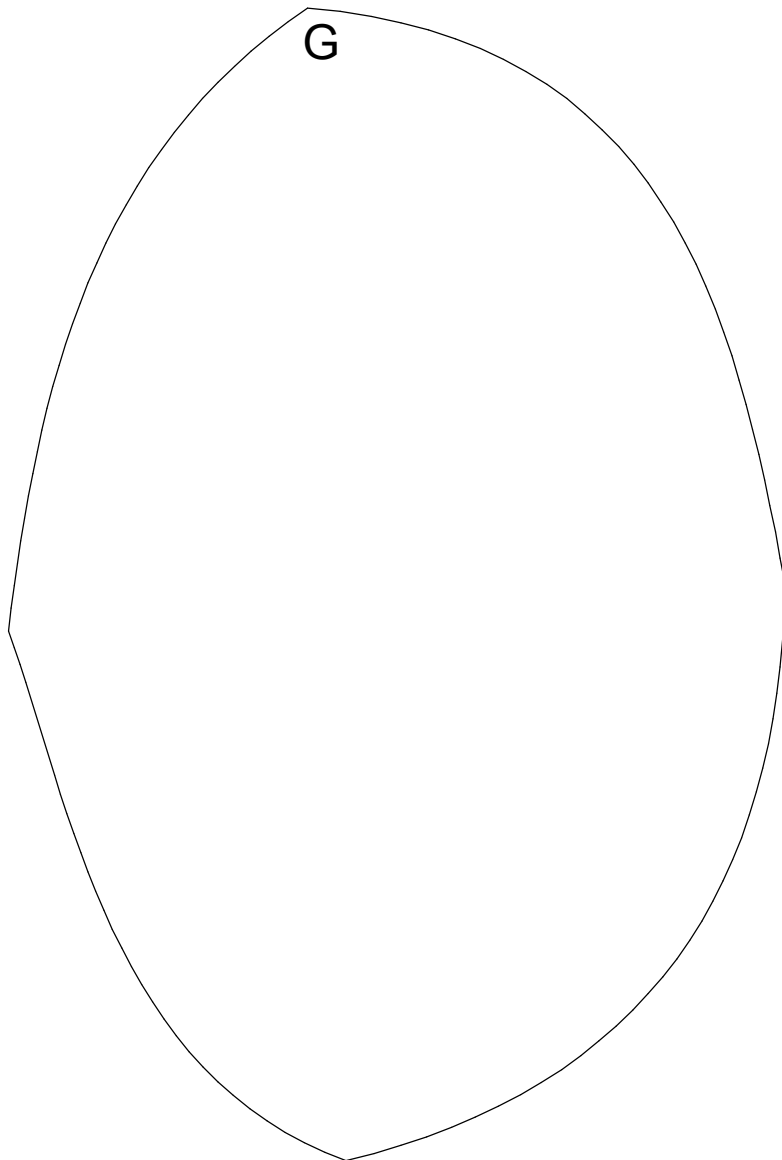
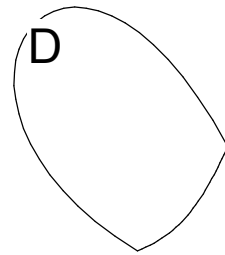
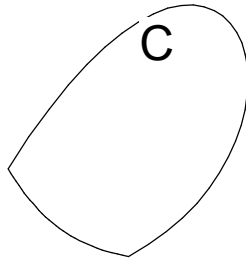
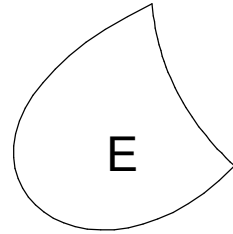
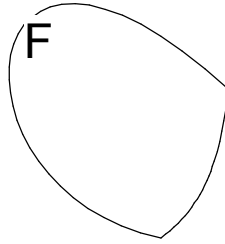
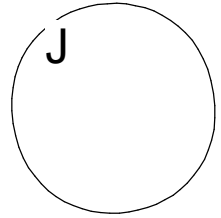
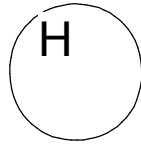
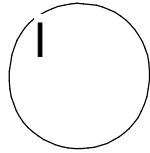


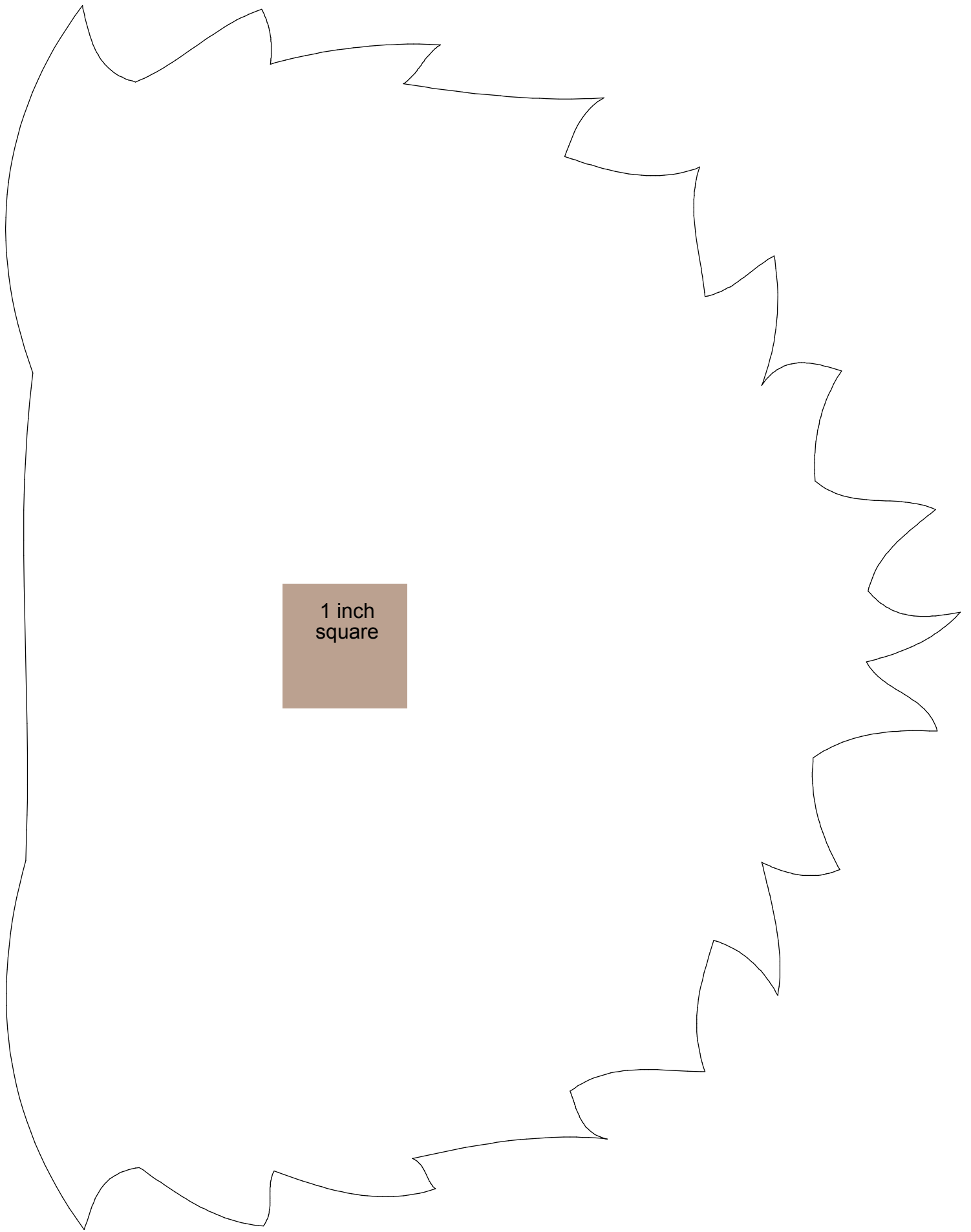
The block is using the technique called raw edge applique.
Please use your choice of applique paper and method of applique.
Finished size will measure 12.5 x 12.5 inches, including the seam allowance.
Always cut your background slightly bigger, as in the process of stitching your pieces the background will shrink a bit.
You can trim the block down to size afterwards.

Step 1
Cut out a background square 12.5 x 12.5 inches, this includes the seam allowance.

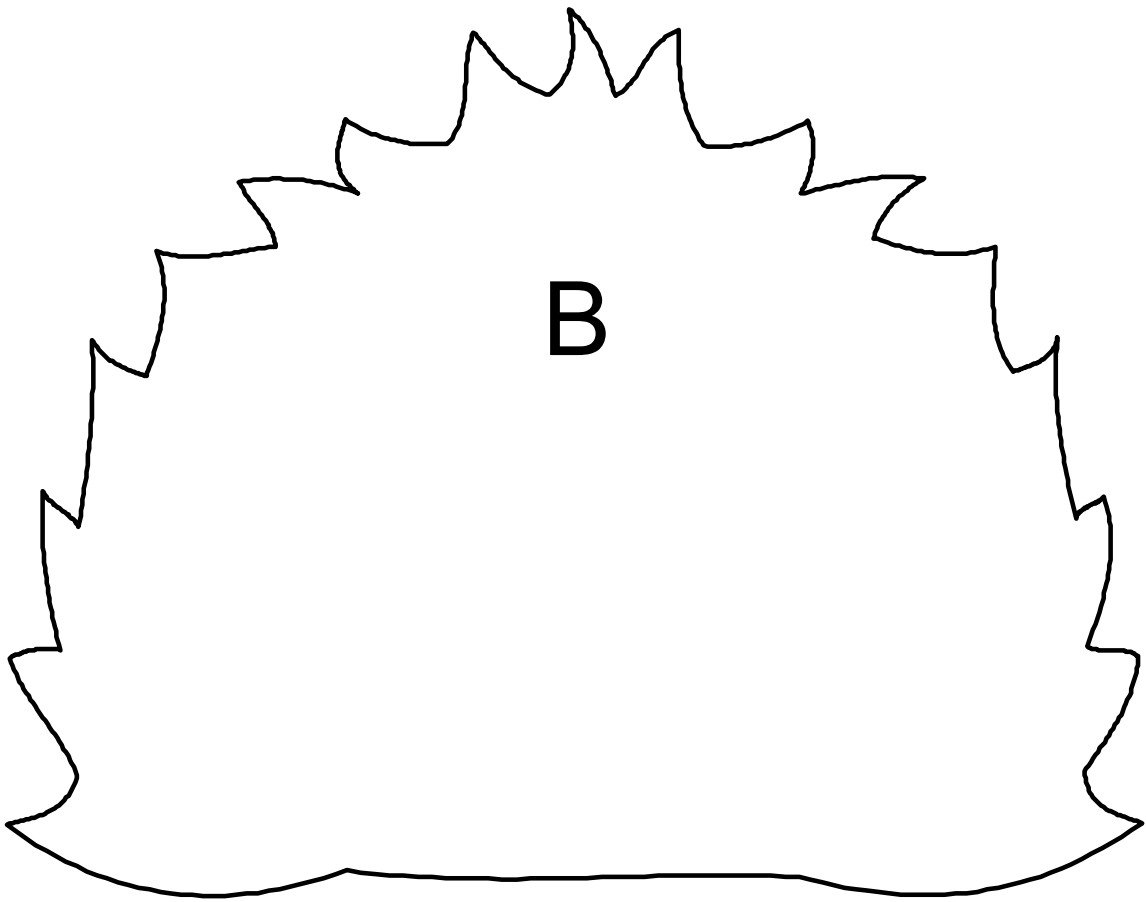

Step 2

Using template B, trace and cut out the spike body of the Hedgehog in your choice of fabric,
Place the hedgehog body in the centre of the background square.

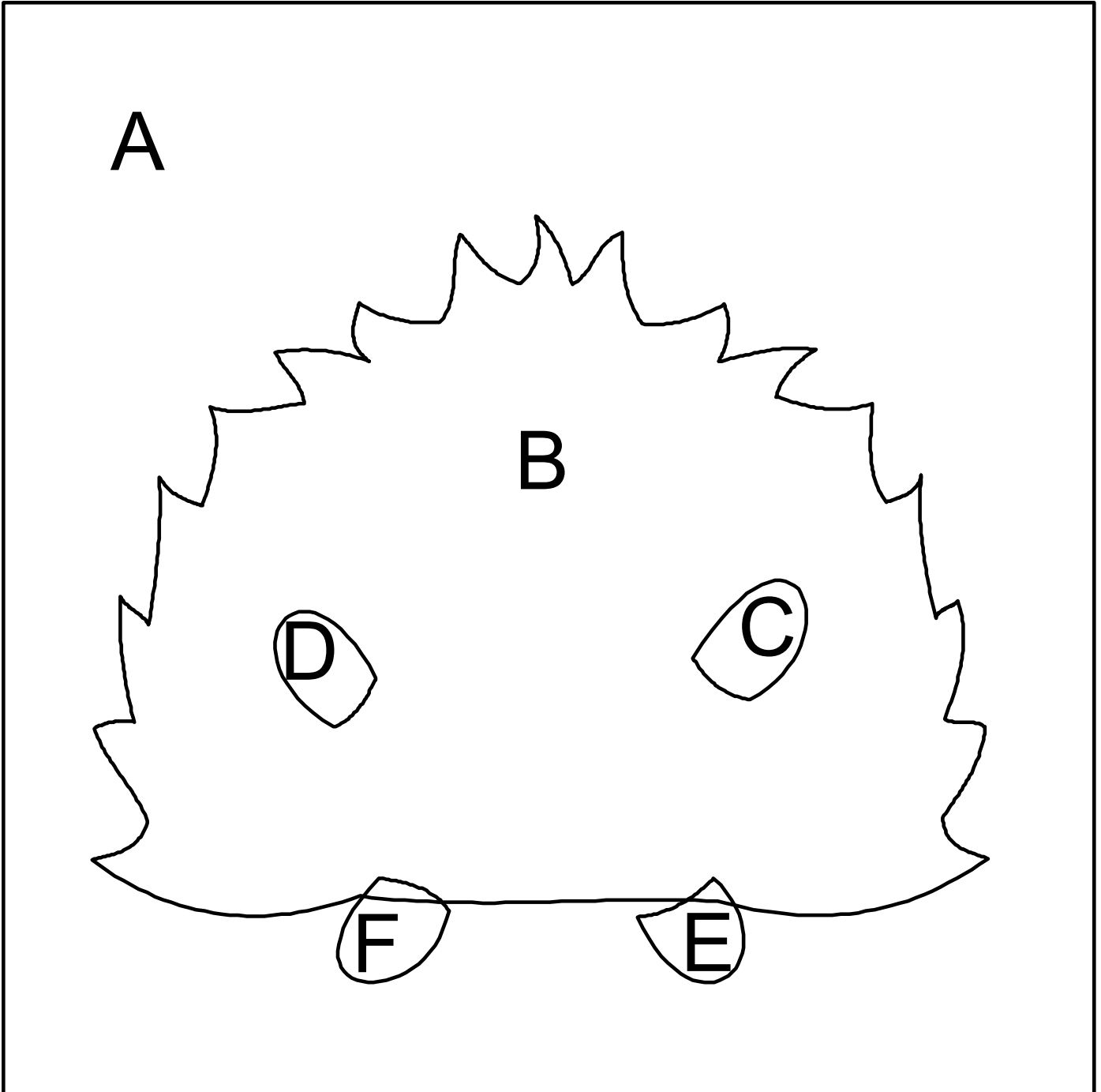


Step 3

Using templates C, D, E, F, trace and cut out the ears and paws of your hedgehog.
And place it in them the corresponding areas as in the picture below.

Important note!

Do not heat press these yet, as you might need to adjust their position after you have placed the head piece.

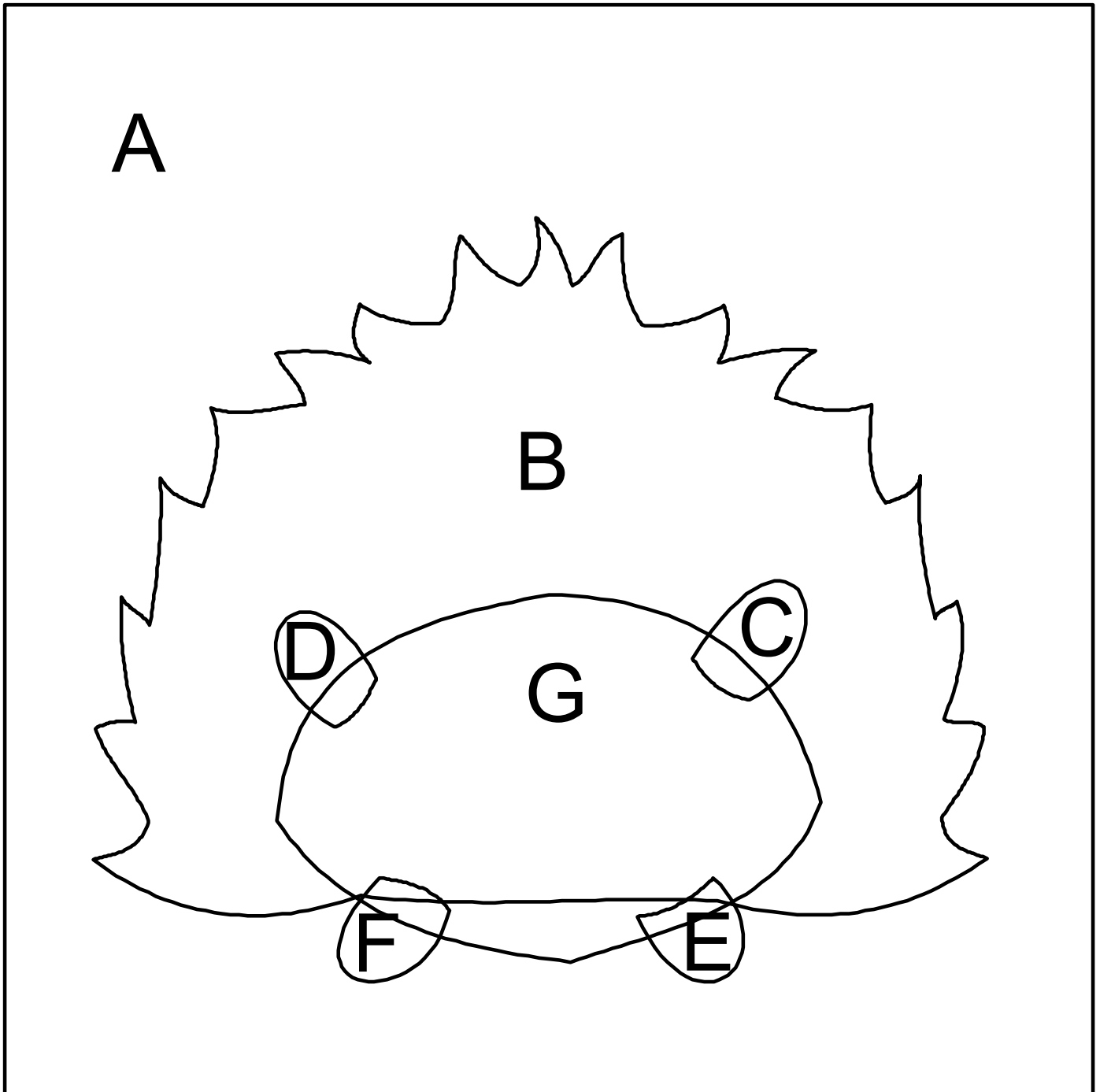


Step 4

Using template G, trace and cut out the shape of the head.

And place it in position over the ears and paws.

This is where you might need to check the position of the ears and paws. And re adjust if needed.



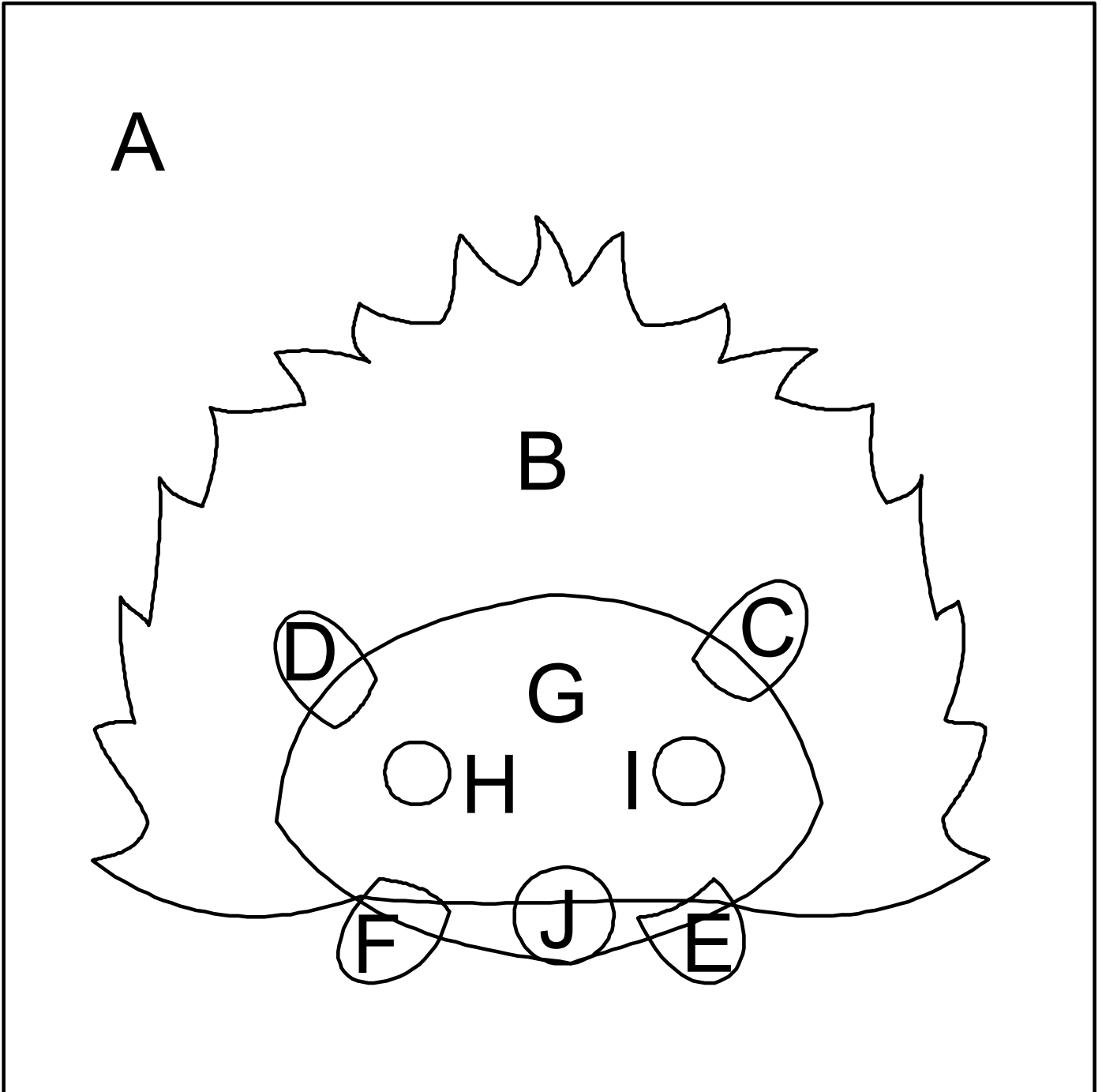
Step 5

The last step.

Trace and cut out the eye and nose pieces. H, I, J.

H & I is the eye pieces and J the nose.

Place these where you would like them to be on the head.
